The typical distraction lasts three seconds enough time for a car going 45 mph
to travel more than half the length of a football field.

According to a Virginia Tech Transportation Institute (VTTI) 2006 study of 100
drivers, driver distractions are the leading cause of most vehicle crashes and
near misses. 80% of crashes and 65% of near misses involve some form of driver
distraction. Most people today consider unsafe driving a threat to themselves
and others who use our roads. LOL I'M NT BSY I'M ONLY DRIVING is the latest
SAJD safety presentation that will make drivers aware of the dangers of driving
distractions.

In this presentation SAJD uses statistics, studies, actual stories and visual effects
to help drivers recognize how distractions reduce their safety. We reinforce the
importance that drivers remain fully focused on the driving task at hand and be
